Racing, Education & Juniors

DCYC enjoys an active year-round racing program with multiple one-design and PHRF fleets. There are four seasonal race series and numerous one-day events as well as casual Wednesday evening racing. The club also hosts numerous sailing education and race-committee training events each year with classes designed for both youth and adult sailors. In addition, the club maintains a fleet of small sailboats available for member use.



Major Regattas & Events

The Club is the original North Texas home of the Leukemia Cup Regatta which has raised over one million dollars in support of leukemia and lymphoma research.

The Club currently features two major seasonal regattas. In the spring, the Corinthian Heritage Cup Regatta draws sailors from area lakes to compete in support of the Dallas Corinthian Educational Fund's youth and adult sailing program.



Our fall regatta, The Terlingua-in-Exile Regatta and Chili Cook-off, is a local favorite that draws numerous area sailors for a great autumn party.

The club acts as host to numerous special events and circuit stops in support of various one-design classes. Recent events include Hobie Mid-America Championships, TSA Pirates of the Corinthian junior regatta, and the North Texas Wind Riders annual Pumpkin Cup.
